TEEN VOLUNTEERS VISIT: July 14-16.

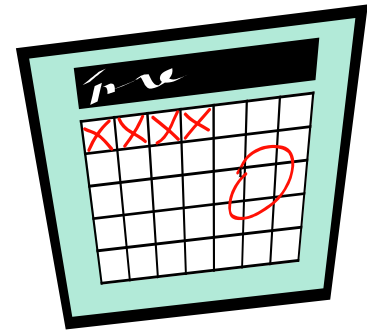

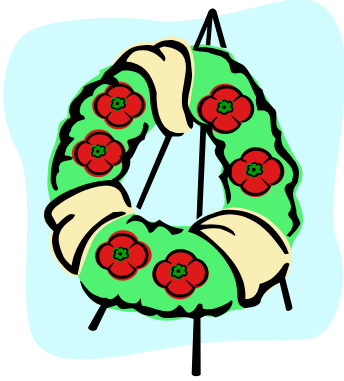
